



A. Registration/Login to Conference Management System (CMT) for ICSEAT 2022


- 1. Please click on the paper submission button found on the <u>conference website submission page</u> to connect to CMT. Alternatively, you may access the <u>CMT webpage</u> directly.
 - If you do not have an account with CMT, please refer to Step 2-4.
 - If you have an existing account with CMT, you can login with your existing email and password. Skip to Step 5.




2. Click "Create Account button" to create an account after entering the CMT.



3. Create an account by filling in the mandatory sections including the * marker.



4. Verify your account by clicking on the verification link that had been sent to your email address (If you did not receive an email, please check your Junk or Spam folder). Upon verification, you are registered to CMT, and you may login to CMT with your email and password.




5. Upon login, the registered conferences are listed in the home page of CMT. Choose International Conference of Sustainable Engineering and Advanced Technologies (ICSEAT 2022). If the ICSEAT 2022 is not listed in your home page, you have to choose ICSEAT 2022 from the "All Conferences" tab.





B. Abstract Submission to ICSEAT 2022

6. After logging into CMT with your email address and password, you can start the submission process by clicking "Create New Submission" button.




7. Fill up the form with the relevant information: (a) Paper title & abstract, (b) authors, (c) corresponding author, (d) relevant subject area and (e) corresponding author details.





8. Return back to the Author Console. You may view the summary and status of your submission.




9. Once submitted, you should receive an **acknowledgement email** with a Paper ID for your reference within 7 days of your submission. The abstract would be reviewed for originality, significance, novelty and scope compatibility. You would be informed of the **abstract outcome** via a separate email within 4 weeks of your abstract submission. For any queries on the conference, please reference the paper ID in your corresponding email.


If you do not receive any acknowledgement email, please check your Spam/Junk folder.

C. Paper Submission to ICSEAT 2022

- 10. When you'd received an email notifying of accepted abstract outcome, you are required to prepare your full paper according to the AIPCP Article Template.
- 11. Once you'd prepared your full paper, please submit your paper through the same CMT system. Log into your CMT, select ICSEAT 2022 conference to enter the Author Console. The author console will indicate that the abstract had been accepted. To submit your paper, click "Edit Submission".




12. The page with all the same information as per Step 7 will appear. You may update the title, abstract and other relevant information here. Upload the full paper in the Files section.



Click save changes once the files are uploaded.

13. Go back to the Author Console to check that the file had been uploaded into the CMT.



- 14. Once submitted, your paper would be sent for a double blind review process. Once the review process had been initiated, the paper status would be changed to "**Under Review**".
- 15. You should receive a **notification email** detailing the outcome of the review. You may also check back the CMT system for any status updates. For any queries on the conference, please reference the paper ID in your corresponding email.



D. Review Outcome & Action


- 16. After the review process is complete, you would receive an email detailing the outcome of the review. There are three possible outcomes:
 - Full Paper Accepted (Step 17-20): Full paper is accepted for publication with minor corrections (if any)
 - Full Paper Revision (Step 21-25): Paper contain technical issue and/or formatting issue that requires endorsement from reviewers
 - Full Paper Rejected (Step 26-28): Paper does not meet established standards

D.1 Accepted - Prepare Camera Ready Submission


17. The authors may view the comments from the reviewers by clicking on the "View Reviews" under the 'Status' column.




18. Once the reviews had been addressed by the authors, the authors may prepare camera ready submission.



19. Check that the title and abstract had been updated to the latest version, and all authors are included.




- 20. At the camera ready submission, you are required to upload two files:
 - Final Abstract Formatted according to the <u>Camera Ready Abstract Template</u>
 - Camera Ready Paper Formatted according to the <u>Camera Ready AIPCP Article Template</u>




D.2 Revision – Revise Paper & Review Process

Revise paper according to reviewer comments, and resubmit for evaluation again. The authors may also choose to submit a new paper.


21. The authors may view the comments from the reviewers by clicking on the "View Reviews" under the 'Status' column.




22. The author may submit the manuscript for re-evaluation. Once the reviews had been addressed by the authors, the authors may upload the revised manuscript.



23. Upload the revised manuscript and click Save.




24. Return back to Author Console, and check that your submission is reflected in CMT system.



25. The revised manuscript would be sent for re-evaluation from Step 14. If the authors wish to submit a new paper, the author may submit a new abstract from Step 6.

D.3 Reject – Full Paper is rejected for publication

26. The authors may view the comments from the reviewers by clicking on the "View Reviews" under the 'Status' column.



- 27. The paper may be rejected due to the following (not limited to) several reasons:
 - a. Severe technical issues, i.e. incomplete data, illogical arguments, unstructured arguments, etc.
 - b. Poor quality content
 - c. Lack of novelty
 - d. High similarity
 - e. Incomprehensible (Poor English writing)
- 28. The authors may choose to submit a new paper for consideration in ICSEAT 2022. If the authors wish to submit a new paper, the author may submit a new abstract from Step 6.
